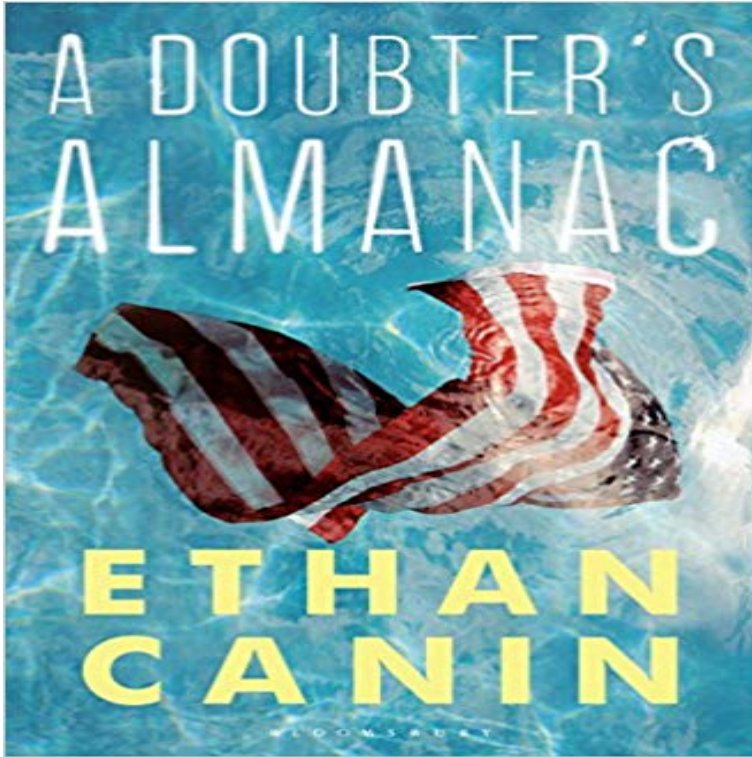


A Doubters Almanac
