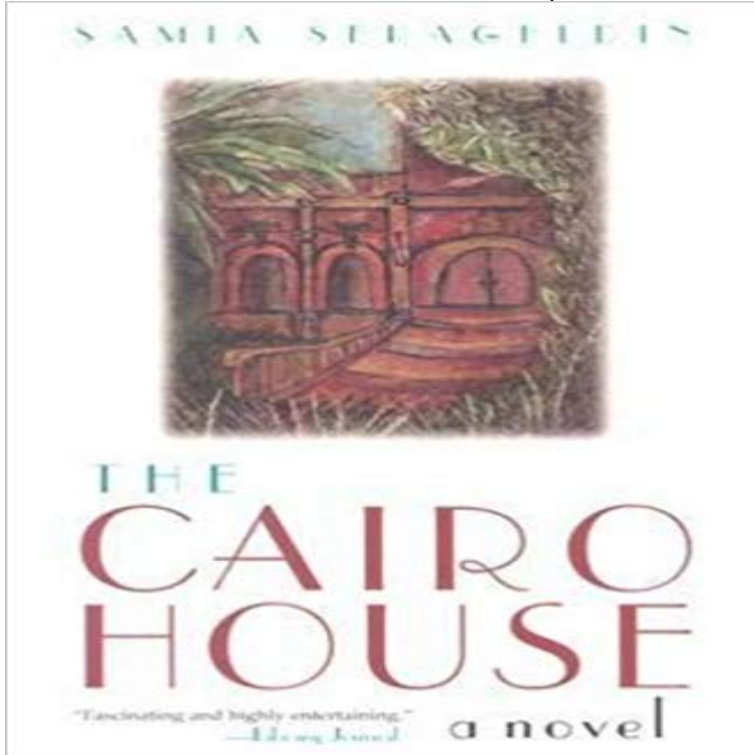


The Cairo House: A Novel (Arab American Writing)
