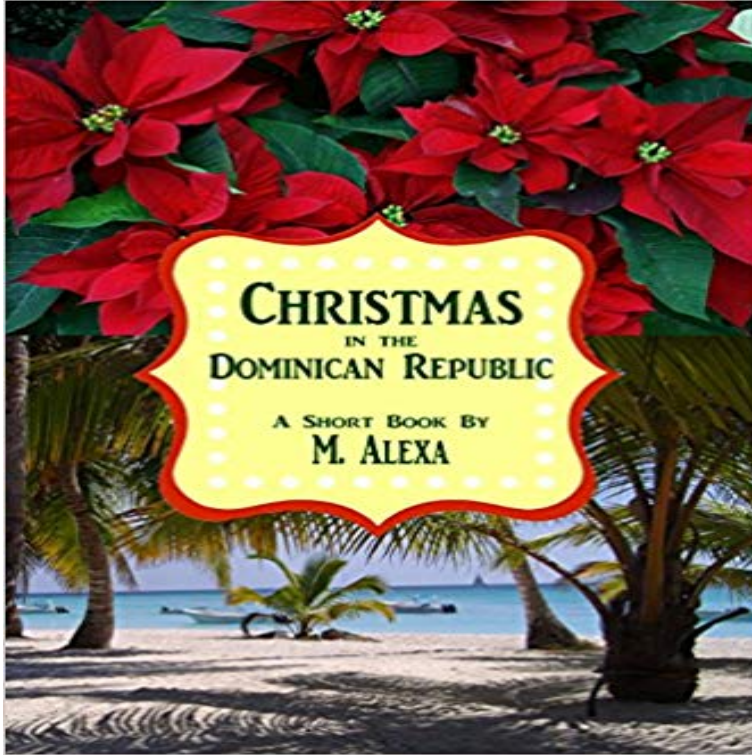


Christmas in the Dominican Republic
