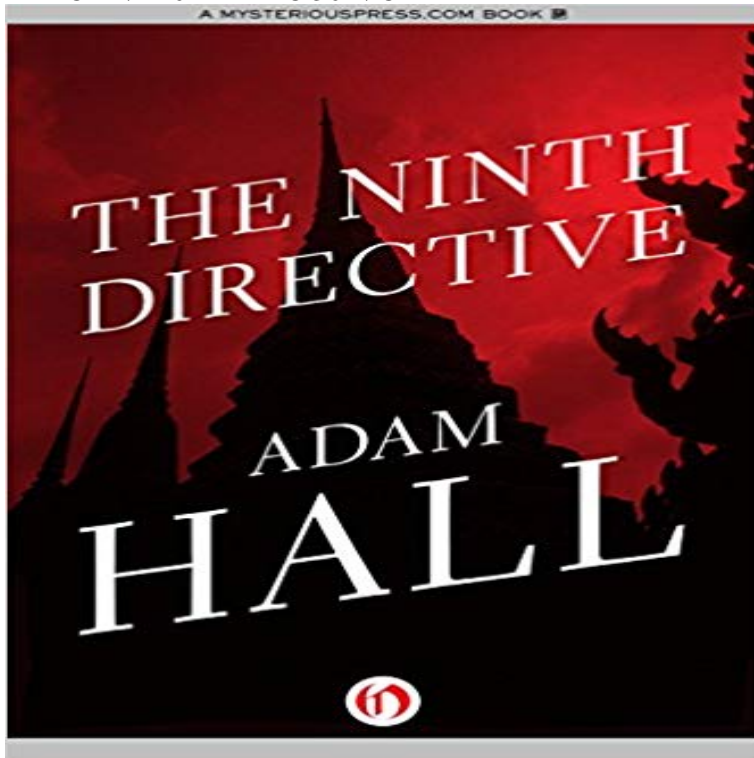


# The Ninth Directive
