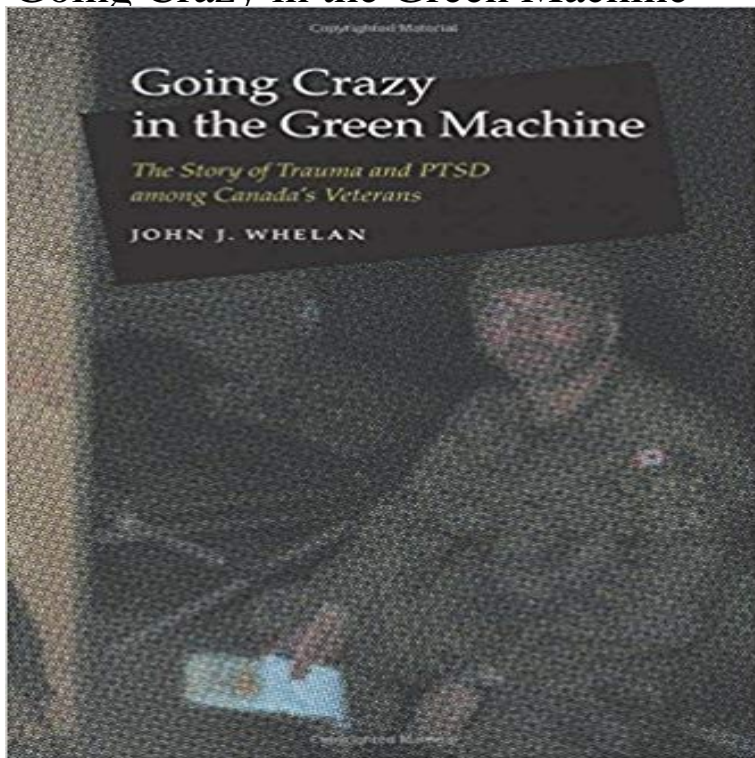


Going Crazy in the Green Machine
