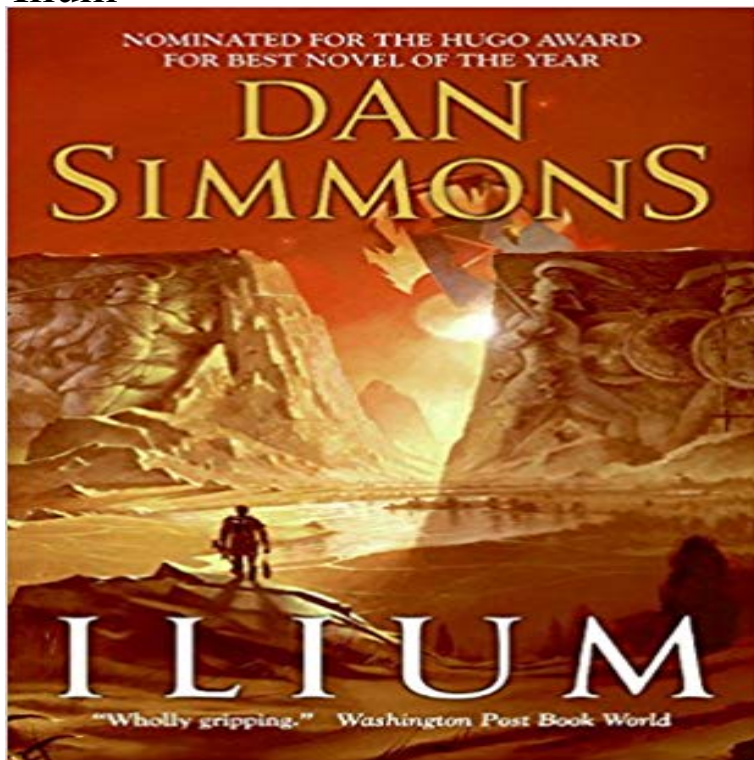


Ilium
