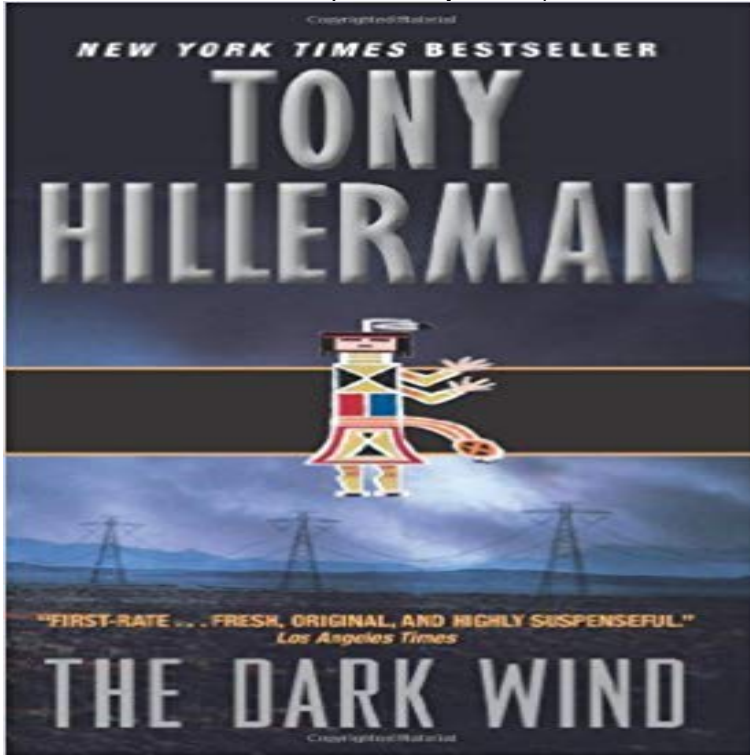


The Dark Wind (Navajo Mysteries Book 5)
