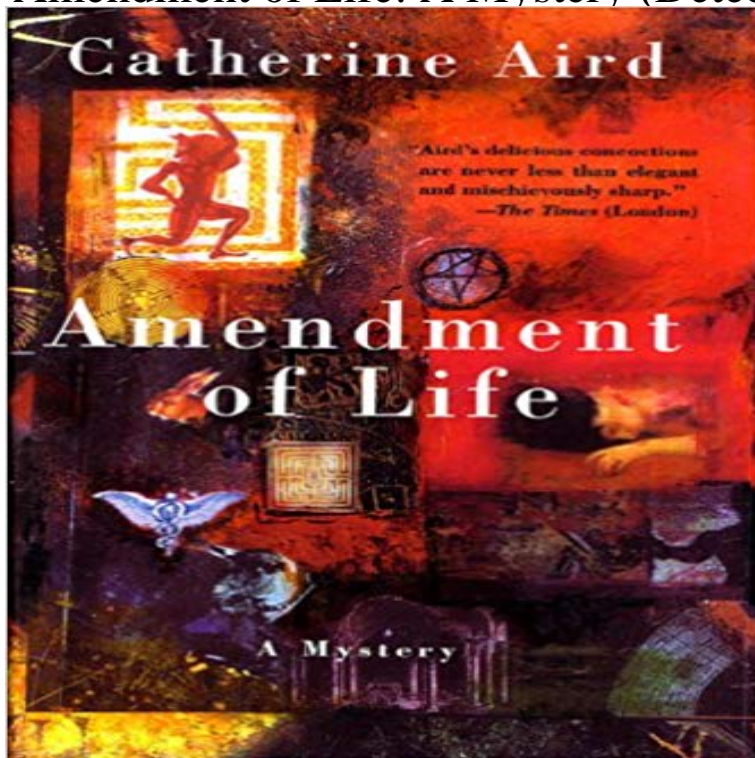


Amendment of Life: A Mystery (Detective Chief Inspector C.D. Sloan)
