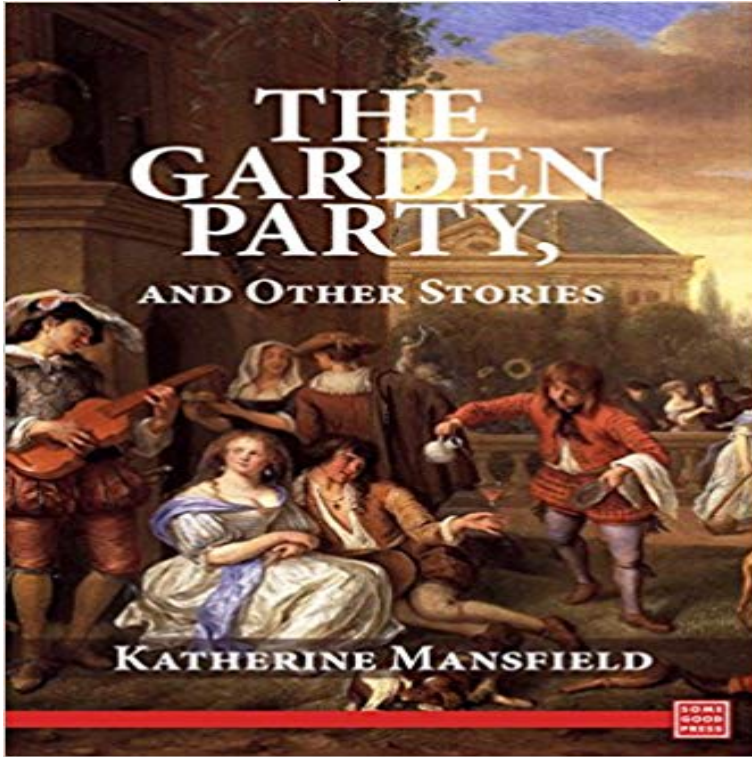

Innovative Kathleen Mansfield Murry (14 October 1888 – 9 January 1923) was a prominent short story writer who was born and brought up in colonial New Zealand. In the title story of this collection, an extravagant garden party coincides with the accidental death of a local working-class man, and the daughter of the party. Written during the final stages of her illness, *The Garden Party and Other Stories* is full of a sense of urgency and was Katherine Mansfield's last collection to be published. Born in New Zealand in 1888, Katherine Mansfield Beauchamp was primarily a writer of short stories. She published *Prelude* and *The Garden Party and Other Stories*.
