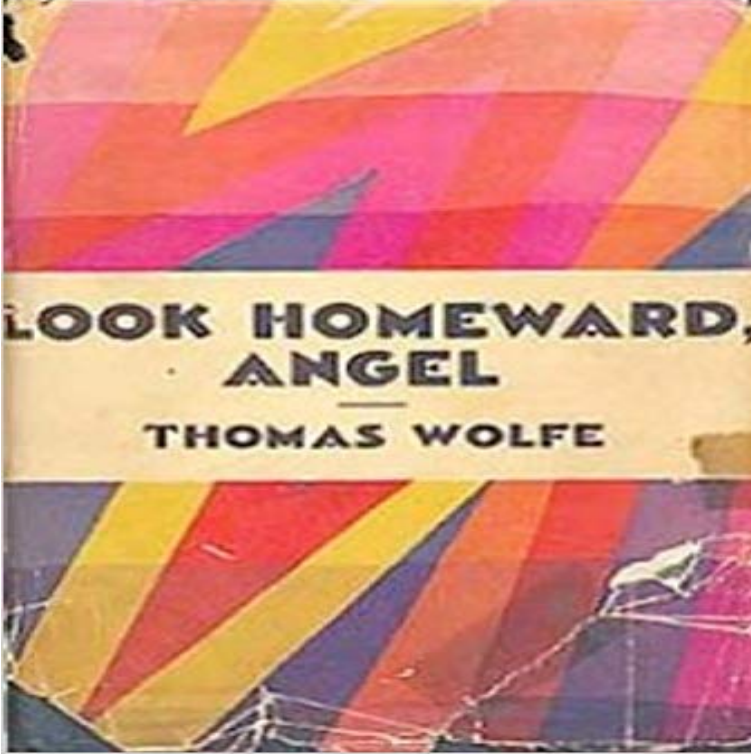


Look Homeward, Angel: A Story of the Buried Life

The setting is the fictional town and state of Altamont, Catawba, a fictionalization of his home town, Asheville, North Carolina.
