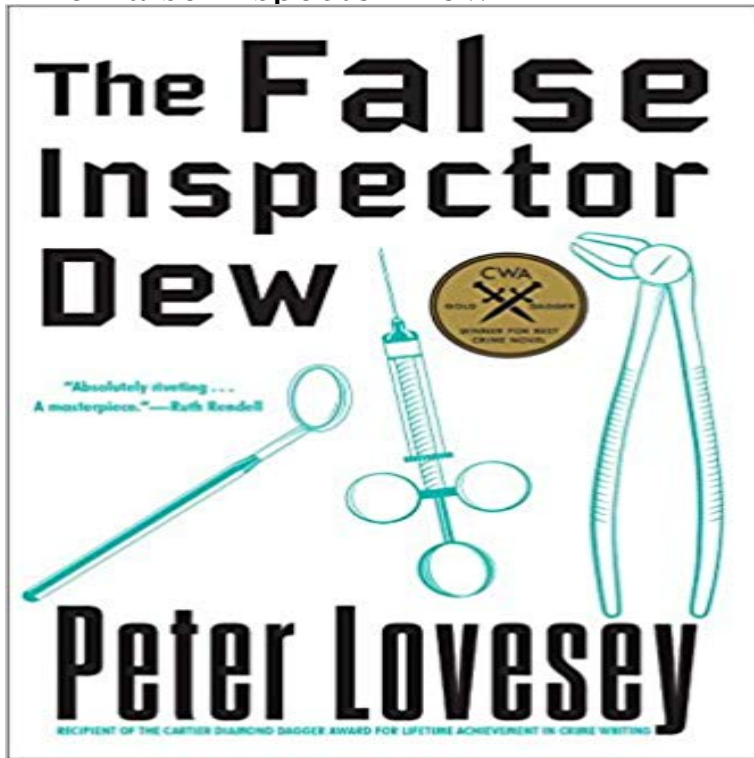


The False Inspector Dew
