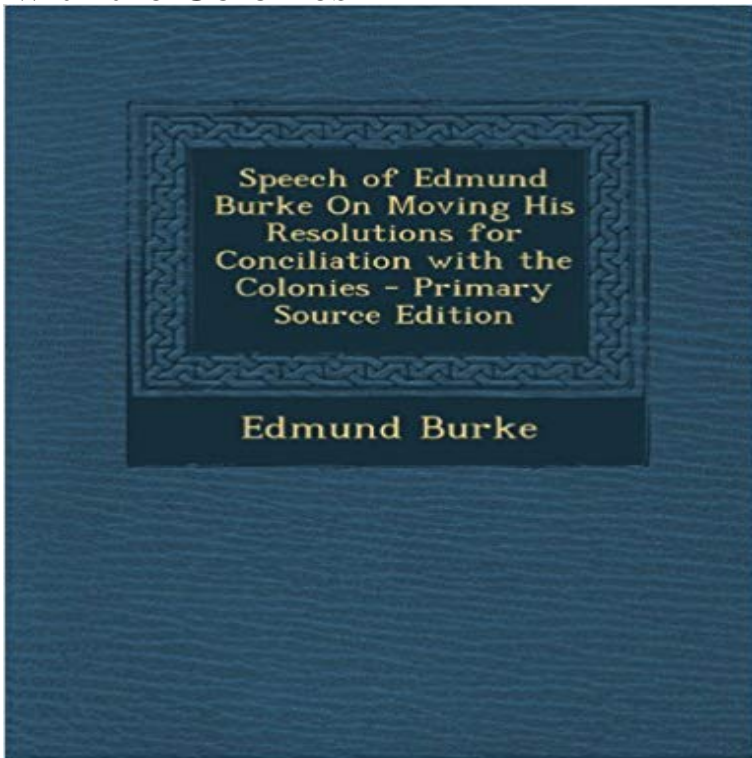


Speech of Edmund Burke on Moving His Resolutions for Conciliation with the Colonies
