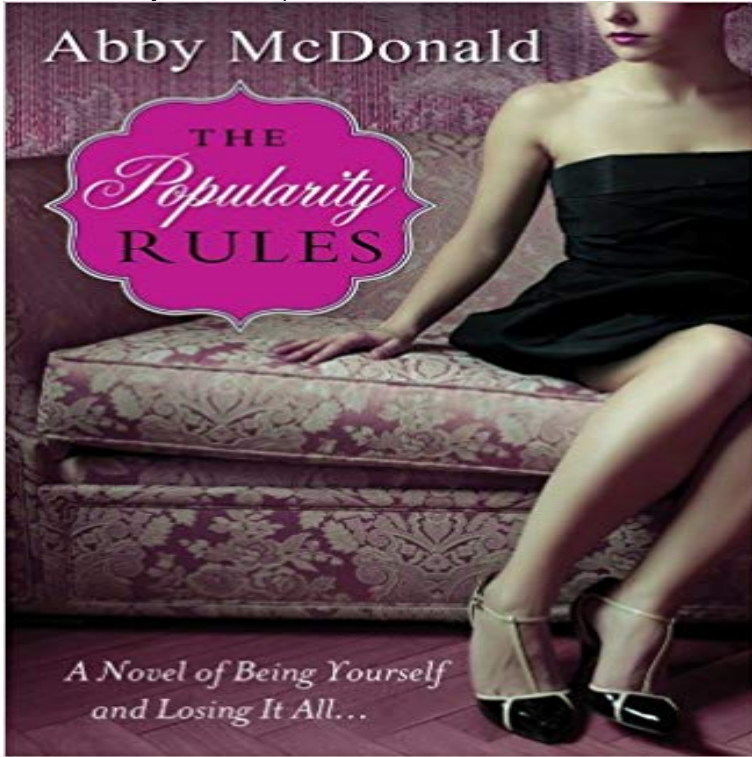


The Popularity Rules
