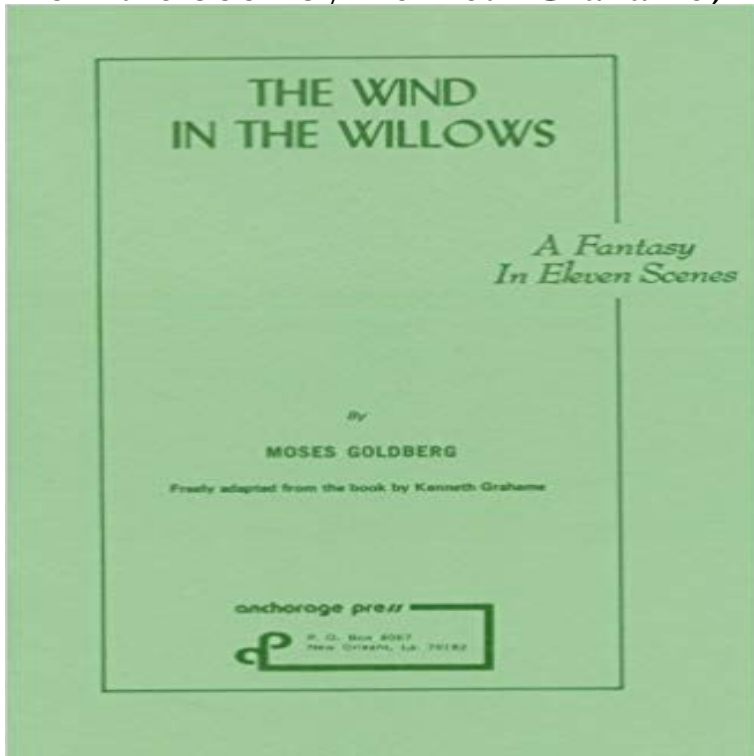


# The Wind in the Willows: A Fantasy in Eleven Scenes (Freely adapted from the book by Kenneth Grahame)
