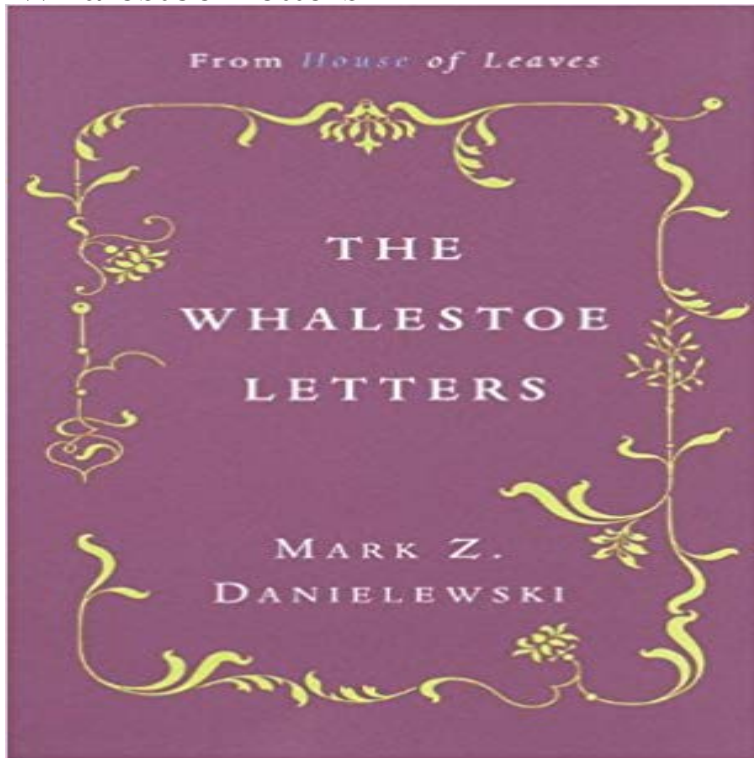


Whalestoe Letters
