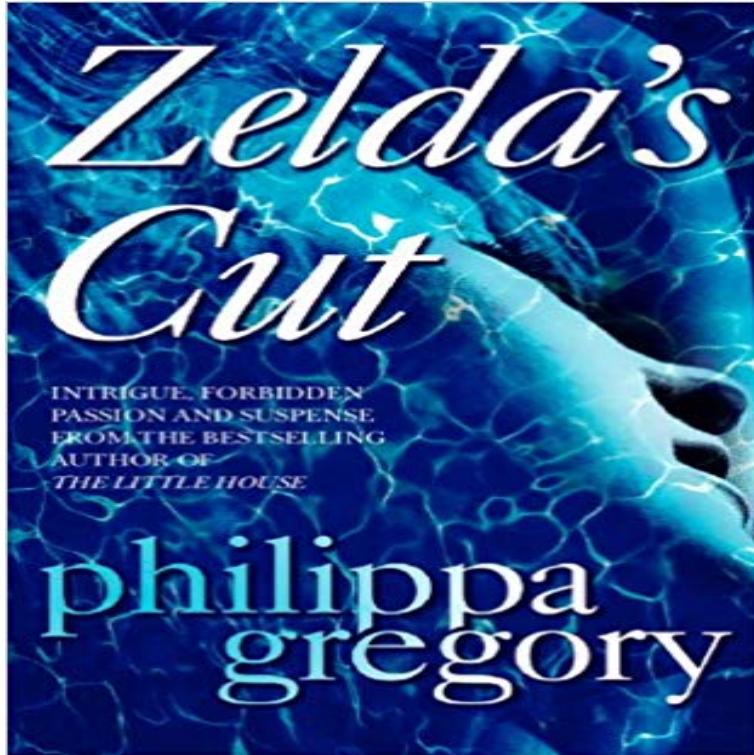


## Zeldas Cut
